



### About Coach Eric Elliott

Diving coach Eric Elliott enters his sixth year at the University of Kansas with head coach Clark Campbell and assistant coach Jen Fox.

During the 2009-2010 season Elliott coached diver Megan Prohl to her 1st NCAA championships. Prohl became the 2nd diver Elliott has had at the NCAA championships.

During the 2008-09 season, Elliot coached diver Erin Mertz to All-American status with her seventh place finish on the one-meter board. Mertz is the first KU diver to earn the honor since Michelle Rojohn won the three-meter diving event in 1996.

Under the direction of Elliott during the 2007-08 campaign, four Kansas divers competed at the 2008 NCAA Zone D. Four KU divers were named to the 2007-08 Academic All-Big 12 team.

The Kansas divers completed an impressive 2006-07 season with three NCAA Zone Diving Championship qualifiers, contributing to Kansas' 6-1 overall record and 2-1 record in the Big 12 Conference.

Current head club coach of Jayhawk Diving Club Tom Davidson will be assisting in the camp as will current KU divers.

Coach Davidson is a 4 time Big Ten Champion and 3 time National champion diver. He also has over 12 years of coaching experience at the college and high school level. He was most recently at Cal-Berkeley where his team re-wrote the record board.

Facilities: Camp will be held at Robinson Hall Pool (located at the west end of the Robinson Hall complex) on the campus of University of Kansas. The facility includes (2) 1 Meter Boards (with spotting harness), (2) 3 Meter Board, (1) 5 Meter Platform, (1) Dry-board (with spotting harness), (1) Trampoline, and TiVo Video Equipment for video analysis.

Directions:

From K-10 Turn Right on Natesmith Dr. follow for 1.5 miles and Robinson Hall will be on right hand side (across the street from Allen Field House).

From I-70 W, follow I-70 W to exit 202. After paying the toll turn south onto McDonald Dr. McDonald then turns into Iowa St. which you will follow for 1.5 Mile. Turn Left onto 19th St then turn Left onto Naismith Dr. Take the 2nd right into the parking lot the pool is on the left behind the tennis courts.

Camp Objectives:

Teach the basics of diving in a safe and educational environment.  
Help divers with previous diving experience to improve their skills.  
Dry-land training with diving specific skills and instruction.  
Have fun and learn new "tricks".

### What makes Jayhawk Diving Camp a safe and educational environment?

Spotting equipment (belts with safety harness) over 1 meter board dry board. This equipment gives the diver the necessary tools to attempt new dives or new skills in a completely safe environment.

TiVo Video Equipment — this equipment is used to give the divers instant video feedback during the practice session.

Camp Conduct: Any action(s) deemed detrimental to the safety and health of oneself or another individual or the destruction of property will result in immediate dismissal from camp with no refund.

### HOUSING & ROOMMATE INFO

Campers and staff are housed in air conditioned Naismith Hall on University of Kansas campus. Roommates are assigned by age unless requested in advance. The dorms are arranged in nice 2-bedroom suites that share a bathroom. Each suite can accommodate up to, but no more than, 4 campers. You may request a roommate and suite-mates, how-ever this is only a request. The Kansas Soccer Camp Staff will make every effort to accommodate all requests, but cannot make any guarantees. Thank you for your patience and understanding in this matter. 24-hour supervision of all campers is provided by the adult staff.

**Residential Option:** Breakfast, lunch and dinner are provided in the Naismith Hall dining area. Campers have the option of ordering pizza at night.
